Neighborhood Garden Guidelines

- ◆ I will plant by June 1st and keep my garden planted all season.
- ◆ If I must abandon my plot, I will notify the garden leadership.
- ◆ I will keep my plot weeded
- ◆ If my plot becomes unkempt, I will be given a one-week notice to clean up. After that it will be reassigned or tilled under.
- ◆ I will keep litter out of the plot.
- ◆ I will help with fall clean-up.
- ◆ I will not plant tall crops where they will shade my neighbors' plants.
- ◆ I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another owner.
- ◆ I will not use chemical fertilizers, insecticides, or weed repellents.
- ◆ I will not bring pets to the garden.
- ◆ I understand that neither the garden group nor St. Aidan's Church is responsible for my actions.
